**HOW YOUR STUDIES BEGIN** 

Please make sure you have your study contract signed both by you and by TUSUR, and that your registration fee of 6000 rubles is paid. Send the receipt to saa@main.tusur.ru and get a confirmation letter from the University.

Classes will start online on the 5<sup>th</sup> of October. One week before your classes start, you will be e-mailed information about your class and your teacher, and instructions on how to use the e-learning platform sdo.tusur.ru.

**HOW THE COURSES WILL BE DELIVERED** 



**TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS** 

The courses will be delivered online via sdo.tusur.ru, the e-learning platform developed by TUSUR University. The Russian language course consists of practical classes delivered in real-time, written assignments and individual work. You have to prepare for every class, revise what you have already learned and do your homework assiduously. Starting in January, your schedule will include engineering disciplines: physics, informatics, mathematics.

Once a week you will have a Social Science class that will inform you about Russia, city of Tomsk, the University, educational system, cultural nuances of your studies and residence. This class is where you are encouraged to ask any

questions about your education and stay in Tomsk.

please make sure that your computer satisfies the following technical requirements:

MEMORY: 1GB minimum

HARD DISC FREE SPACE: at least 500 MB

WEB BROWSER: last version of Chrome or FireFox RECOMMENDED SPEED OF INTERNET CONNECTION:

**HOW TO QUARANTINE AFTER ARRIVAL** 

You can arrive to Tomsk as soon as the Russian government lifts its travel restrictions for international students. But what you can do now is prepare the documents for your visa application.

You need to visit the web site of the Russian Embassy in your country and find the list of the documents necessary to apply for a student visa. TUSUR University will provide you with your study contract (normally you already have it), letter of admission and the official invitation.

Please be aware that the official invitation cannot be issued until the travel restrictions are lifted. The remaining documents for your visa application will be your responsibility. When you have your visa, you can buy a ticket for Tomsk and arrive in TUSUR University to continue your studies on-campus.

When arriving to Tomsk, all international students are required to undergo a 14-day guarantine at the TUSUR Quarantine Center in its dormitory on 10 Lytkina Street.

To check in the Quarantine Center, you need to present your passport for legally-required residence registration.

The University will provide you with three meals daily and WiFi access free of charge for the duration of your 14-day stay. 10 days after checking in, you will be PCR-tested and if your test is negative, you will move to the international students' dormitory where a room will be booked for you.
